State Stabilization Funds

- Used for Public Safety Initiatives – can be used for education

81.2%

\$85,644,000

- Distributed between K-12 and Higher Education to cover budget shortfalls
- Remaining Funds based on State Funding Formulas

- Title I, Part A Grant – \$27,415,262
- Title I, School Improvement Grant – \$7,145,000
- Educational Technology Grant – \$3,209,375
- Homeless Grant – \$150,000
- IDEA Grant – \$27,413,988

- **Remaining Funds** – those funds that were not needed to cover budget shortfalls
- Funds will be distributed to LEAs based on the Title I Funding Formula
- **Allowed Use** – can be used for activities under:
  - ✓ Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA)
  - ✓ Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA)
  - ✓ Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act (Perkins)
  - ✓ Building Modernization
  - ✓ Adult Education and Family Literacy Act
